

EMERGENCY, UNCLASSIFIED OR TRAINEE APPOINTMENT

Check one:

EMERGENCY: In the event of unforeseen emergency, the appointing authority may appoint any person to fill a position. Emergency employees may work no longer than ten working days and such appointments are not renewable. No person shall receive more than three appointments in one calendar year. Conditions necessitating the emergency appointment must be explained here.

UNCLASSIFIED: Unclassified employees are not subject to the provisions of the Civil Service Law, but the law requires all such appointments be reported to this department.

TRAINEE: Each appointment must be approved by the Director of Civil Service and reported to the Civil Service Board. The duration of the appointment must not exceed one year and can be approved only if an approved training program is in existence.
