We, Aurel Parenteau, David Perreault and Ronald Paradis, the three judges appointed by resolution of the County Board of Red Lake County, Minnesota, hereby certify that we acted as judges in the election duly called by the County Board to decide whether the area described in a petition heretofore described in a petition presented to the County Board should incorporate as a village.

We further certify that the election was held on the 31st day of March, 1955, in the Poplar River Town Hall located within the proposed incorporation area; that the polls were open from 10 o'clock in the morning until 8 o'clock in the evening of said day; that the election was conducted at the time, place and on the date set out in the resolution of the County Board calling for the election; that the number of ballots cast for incorporation exceeded the number against incorporation; that we have canvassed the ballots cast; that there were 51 ballots cast in favor of incorporation and there were 28 ballots cast against incorporation.

PETITION

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RED LAKE COUNTY:

Your petitioners respectfully show to the County Board:

That this petition is made for the purpose of requesting the County Board to call an election pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 412.011 to determine whether the residents of the area described hereinbelow favor incorporation of the area as a Village.

That attached to this petition is a Census List of the residents of the area within the following boundaries, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the North Section line of section 15 in the township of Poplar River, Red Lake County, Minnesota, 820 feet west of the Northeast corner of said section 15, thence south at right angles 500 feet, thence east at right angles 310 feet, thence south at right angles 770 feet thence east at right angles 510 feet to the east line of said section 15, thence south along said east section line to the south line of section 14, thence east along said south line of section 14 to the north south center line of said section 14, thence north along said north south center line of section 14 to the center of section 14, thence east along the east west center line of section 14 to the north south center line of the Northeast quarter of said section 14, thence north along the north south center line of the north east quarter of section 14 and the southeast quarter of section 11 to the east west center line of section 11, thence west along the east west center line of section 11 and section 10 to the north south center line of the southeast quarter of section 10 thence south along said north south center line of the southeast quarter of section 10 to the north section line of section 15, thence east along said north section line to the point of beginning.

That the quantity of land included within said boundaries is approximately 741 acres.

That the number of actual residents of said area is 175 as shown by the attached census list. That said census was made by the person who have verified said census list and that said census takers have also verified this petition.

That the area proposed to be incorporated is that area lying within the boundaries hereinabove set out and that said area contains approximately 741 acres.

That the proposed name of village is Brooks.

That a portion of the area hereinabove described has been platted.

That the undersigned petitioners are all voters who have resided continuously within the territory proposed to be incorporated for at least 2 years prior to the date of this petition.

WHEREFORE your petitioners respectfully request the County Board to call an election on the question of incorporation pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 412.011.
