The undersigned petitioners do hereby represent and state:

I

That they are legal voters residing within a territory not included in, but adjacent to the Village of Fairfax, Minnesota, a Municipal Corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Minnesota; said territory being within the boundaries described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southeast Quarter (SEL) of Section Five (5) in Township One Hundred Twelve (112) North. #### RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY VILIAGE COUNCIL OF VILLAGE OF

# MAIRFAX, MINNESOTA, ON MARCH 21, 1965

The following resolution was introduced by Trustee Dittmer, who moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, there is an area of land containing approximately 75 acres, and adjacent to but not included in the Village of Fairfax, Minnesota, no part of which is more than one and one-half miles from the present corporate limits of said Village, said territory being within the boundaries described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northwest Corner of the Southeast Quarter (SD) of Section Five (5) in Township One Hundred Twelve (112) North, Range Thirty-two (32) West, Renville County, Minnesota; thence East along the North line of said Southeast Quarter of said Section Five (5) to the West side of the Right-Of-Way of Minnesota State Trunk Highway Number Four (4); thence Southerly along the West side of said Right-Of-Way meets the West line of the Southeast Quarter (SE) of Section Bight (8) in Township One Hundred Twelve (112) North, Range Thirty-two (32) West, Renville County, Minnesota; and thence North along the West line of said Southeast Quarter (SE) of said Section Bight (8), the West line of the Northeast Quarter (NE) of said Section Eight (8), and the West line of said Southeast Quarter (SE) of said Section Five (5) to the point of beginning, and

WHERMAS, Mimer J. Kiecker, Leo G. Jandl, Kenneth Hess, Max Schrodder, Paul Kern, Oscar Steeber, Louis G. Borth and Theresa Schefus, being legal voters of said area, did on the 14th day of March, 1955, cause to be taken and did take a census of the resident population of said territory, and found that there were, on that date, at least One Hundred Seventy-seven (177) persons residing within said territory, and did, on the 21st day of March, 1955, file in the office of the Village Clerk of said Village of Fairfax, a petition proposing that said territory be annoxed to said Village and become a part thereof, and praying the Village Council of said Village of Fairfax to call an election for the determination of such proposed annexation, in accordance with the Statutes in such case made and provided, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of said Village of Fairfax finds that the annexation of said territory would be to the best interests of the Village and of said territory.

SO THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that an election he held on the annexation of said territory on Tuesday, the 5th day of April, 1955, between the hours of 9:00 o'clock A.M. and 5:00 o'clock P.M. at Lemmers Lumber Company in said territory.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Paul Kern, Anton Seesz and Clara Steeber, three residents of said territory be, and they hereby are, appointed as Judges of said Election; and that the Clerk cause ten days' posted notice of said Election to be given, and furnish to said Judges sufficient ballots and election supplies, at the expense of the Village of Fairfax.

Nelson, Albert Dittmer, Roland Berdan and George Nelson, and the following voted against the same, None, whereupon said Resolution was declared to have been duly adopted.
