KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, MILES LORD,  
Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the  
authority vested in me by statute, and particularly Minnesota  
Statutes 1953, Section 8.06, do hereby constitute and appoint

CHARLES E. NIEMAN

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, to be a Special Assistant Attorney  
General, on the request of the Commissioner of Agriculture,  
Dairy and Food of the State of Minnesota, for the purpose of  
performing from time to time such legal duties as may be  
assigned to or requested of him by said Commissioner.


The compensation of said Special Assistant Attorney  
General shall be paid by the Commissioner of Agriculture,  
Dairy and Food out of funds of that department, pursuant to  
verified statements submitted twice a month to the Commissioner,  
showing the number of hours expended by counsel in the perform-  
ance of his duties under this appointment, together with a  
list of work performed or services rendered. The compensation  
and the payment of expenses necessarily incurred in the per-  
formance of his duties shall continue until otherwise deter-  
mined, but said compensation and payment of expenses shall not  
exceed Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000) during any fiscal year.

Any written legal opinion rendered by said Special  
Assistant must be released through the office of Attorney  
General, and any court action or proceedings in which such  
Special Assistant is to appear must first be approved by the  
Attorney General.


Said appointee shall serve at the pleasure of




