A Proclamation for "Know Your Bank Week"

WHEREAS, the successful operation of our economic institutions as well as the convenience and security with which we carry on our personal economic affairs depend upon a sound, constructive banking system; and

WHEREAS, a clearer understanding on the part of the public of the part played by banks in our economic life and of the services which they offer will assist individuals and businesses in their planning and operations and will make it easier for the banking industry to serve the public in the interest of greater prosperity and future development; and

WHEREAS, banks, in their desire to create a clearer understanding of how the banking industry serves the public, will observe May 1-7, 1955 as "Know Your Bank Week";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of May 1-7, 1955, as

"Know Your Bank Week"

and suggest that citizens visit banking institutions during this observance in order to develop a better understanding of the vital part played by banks in our economic life.
