A Proclamation for "American Youth Hostel Week"

WHEREAS, the friendly comradeship and wide understanding that can be developed among youth of many regions and many lands can be a major factor in the development of a degree of sympathy and understanding among peoples that will contribute materially to the achievement of a peaceful world; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Council of the American Youth Hostels, Incorporated is engaged in an effort to further the wide and happy comradeship of youth through traveling and living with people in many different areas both at home and abroad; and

WHEREAS, the American Youth Hostel program provides an opportunity for young people to travel under circumstances which they can afford and under conditions which contribute to physical health and spiritual and social development; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Council of American Youth Hostels is making a special effort to promote this constructive program during the week of May 1 to May 8, 1955;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 1 to May 8, 1955, as

"AMERICAN YOUTH HOSTEL WEEK"

and urge that special attention be given to the values of understanding and good will that can be furthered by the Youth Hostel Program.
