A Proclamation for "National and Inter-American Music Week"

WHEREAS, the enjoyment, performance and appreciation of music constitute an important part of the cultural life of Minnesota and of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the National and Inter-American Music Week Committee is contributing to wholesome recreation, cultural advance, and individual and social appreciation of music by special observance of the week of May 1 to 8, 1955;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 1-8, 1955, as

"NATIONAL AND INTER-AMERICAN MUSIC WEEK"

and urge the participation, support, and enjoyment of programs in observance of this occasion.
