

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a certain petition, dated March 29, 1955 requesting that an election be held on the question of incorporating a certain territory described therein as the Village of Lino Lakes, Minnesota, was duly presented to this Board on the 5th day of April, 1955; and WHEREAS, the said petition is in proper form and it appears therefrom that the same was signed by the requisite number of qualified persons and that the territory described therein contains a resident population of 1814, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka, Minnesota:

1. An election is hereby called and directed to be held on the 3rd day of May, 1955 at W. and R. Garage, Highway #8 at Lino, at which election all qualified voters residing within the territory described in said petition can or may vote for or against the incorporation of said territory as the Village of Lino Lakes, Minnesota, and the polls at said election shall be open from 9 o'clock in the morning until 9 o'clock in the evening of said day.

Dolor Nadeau, Hugo, Dorothy Rehbein, Hugo, and Violet Moga, New Brighton Rt. 12, all residing within said territory, are hereby appointed to be judges at said election, and that the following persons, residing in the territory are appointed as alternate judges to serve as such only if one or more of the above judges is unable or fails to act and the alternates, herein designated, are to serve in the order herein named, in the case a vacancy or vacancies arise, Juliet Erickson, Hugo, Marcella Kelling, Hugo, and R. V. Ellingson, Hugo, and they shall conduct said election as so far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers.

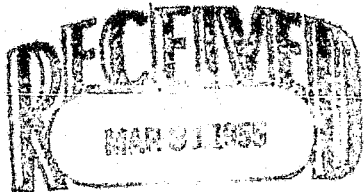
