An Ordinance authorizing certain land from Village of New Hope.

The Village Council of the Village of New Hope ordains:

Section 1. All the property owned of the land hereinafter described having petitioned the Village Council of the Village of New Hope and the Village of Crystal to have said land detached from the Village of New Hope and annexed to the Village of Crystal, and it appearing that it is unincorporated land situated within the corporate limits of the Village of New Hope but adjacent to the Village of Crystal, and the Village Council of the Village of New Hope having determined that the change will be for the benefit of the Village and the land affected, it is hereby determined that said property shall be and is hereby detached from the Village of New Hope, the same being legally described as follows:

The west sixty (60) feet of that part of lot thirty-two (32), Addition's subdivision to, 225, Hennepin County, Minnesota, lying east of lot two (2), Block One (1), Murray Lane North Addition.

Section 2. Certified copies of this Ordinance shall be filed by the clerk in the office of the County Recorder of Hennepin County, Minnesota, and in the office of the Secretary of State.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies thereof in the offices above mentioned as required by law, and the adoption of an ordinance by the Village Council of the Village of Crystal annexing said territory to the Village of Crystal and the filing of certified copies of said Ordinance as required by law.

The Village Council of the Village of Crystal Ordinance

Section 1. All of the corners of the lands hereinafter described being  
petitioned to the Village Council to have said lands included within the Village of  
Crystal, and it appearing that said property abuts upon the Village of Crystal  
that it has been surveyed from the Village of New Hope by boundaries adopted by  
the Village Council, conditional upon acceptance of said tract by the Village of  
Crystal; that it is so conditional as to be properly subjected to village  
jurisdiction; that it is unincorporated and contains no resident population; and the  
Village Council having determined that the acquisition of said property will be  
in the best interests of the Village and of the Territory of Crystal, it is hereby  
ordained that

The east thirty (30) feet of west part of lot thirty-two  
(32), Auditor's Subdivision No. 226, Hennepin County,  
Minnesota, lying east of lot one (1), Block Two (2),  
Survey Town North Division

be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Crystal.

Section 2. Certified copies of this Ordinance shall be filed by the  
Village Clerk in the offices of the County Auditor of Hennepin County, Minnesota  
and the Secretary of State.

Section 3. The Village of New Hope having already adopted an ordinance  
detaching said lands from said Village, conditional upon the same being accepted  
by the Village of Crystal, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and  
after its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies thereof  
in the offices hereinafter as required by law.
