

ORDINANCE NO. 2 4 7

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON,
MINNESOTA.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, DO ORDAIN:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 413.14, and all amendments thereto, of
the Minnesota Statutes for 1941, a majority of the owners of property
hereinafter described, have petitioned the City Council of the City of
Worthington to have such property annexed to said City; and

WHEREAS it is desired that said territory become a part of said City
of Worthington, the same as if it had been originally a part thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, The following described territory is hereby declared
to be a part of the City of Worthington; to wit,

All that territory included in that certain plat on file and of record
in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for the County of Nobles, State
of Minnesota, known as the Plat of the Lake Shore Parker Subdivision of
Part of Government Lots 3 and 4, Section 22, Township 102 North, Range 40
West of the 5th P.M., in the County of Nobles, State of Minnesota.
