Commissioner Christensen offered the following resolution, and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, A certain petition dated April 14, 1955, requesting that an election be held on the question of incorporating certain territory described therein as the Village of Medina, Minnesota, was duly presented to this Board on the 19th day of April, 1955; and

WHEREAS, Said petition is in proper form and it appears therefrom that the same was signed by the requisite number of qualified persons and that the territory described therein contains a resident population of 1,151 persons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Hennepin, Minnesota, that

1. An election is hereby called and directed to be held on the 21st day of May, 1955, at the Medina Town Hall, at which election all qualified voters residing within the territory described in said petition may vote for or against the incorporation of said territory as the Village of Medina, Minnesota, and the polls at said election shall be open from 9:00 o'clock A.M., until 5:00 o'clock P.M.

J. F. Hatcher, J. F. Crahan, and Arthur S. Gerts, and as alternate, Wilfred Scherer, all of Medina, Minnesota, and all residing within the territory to be incorporated, are hereby appointed to be the judges at said election, and they shall conduct the same so far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the County Auditor cause notice of said election to be given in the manner prescribed by law.

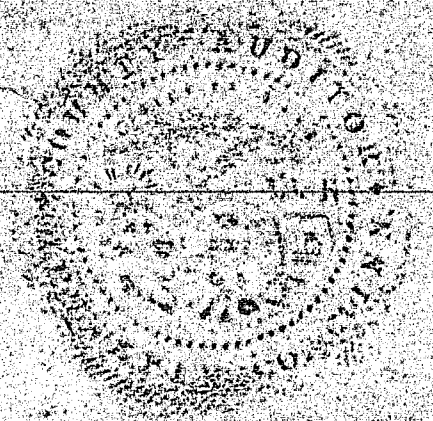

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION

TO: The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Hennepin, Minnesota.

We, the undersigned, residents of the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your honorable board to fix a time and place when and where the resident voters within said territory may vote on the question of incorporating the same as a village, and for that purpose respectfully state:

1. That all of your petitioners are qualified voters and residents within the territory hereinafter described, and each has resided continuously within said territory for at least two years prior to the date of this petition.
2. None of the territory hereinafter described is now a part of any incorporated city or village.
3. The territory which it is proposed to incorporate consists partly of lands which have been platted into lots and blocks, which plats have been duly and legally made and certified according to the laws of this state and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of the County of Hennepin, Minnesota, and partly of unplatted lands which adjoin the platted area and are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government. All of said lands, platted and unplatted, lie entirely within the County of Hennepin, Minnesota, and the description of said lands, both platted and unplatted, is as follows:

All of the Township of Medina, Hennepin County, Minnesota, excepting the Village of Loretto.

4. The boundaries of the foregoing are as follows:

Surrounded on the North by the Township of Corcoran; on the East by the Township of Plymouth; on the South by the Village of Orono; on the West by the Township of Independence and the Village of Maple Plain.

5. The quantity of land, both platted and unplatted, embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described is 17,120 acres, be the same more or less.
6. The foregoing lands, both platted and unplatted, and bounded as described, contain a resident population of 1,151 persons, as ascertained by a census which was commenced on the 11th day of April, 1955, and completed on the 14th day of April, 1955, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
7. The name of the Village proposed to be incorporated is the Village of "Medina."

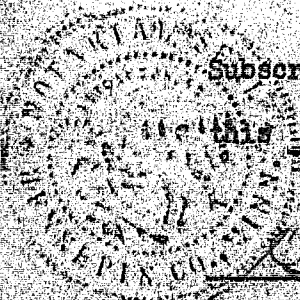

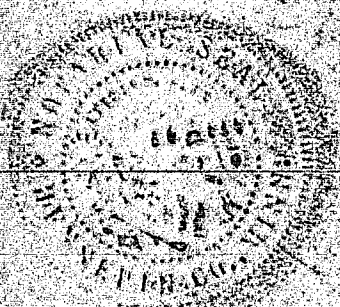
