

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF HECTOR  
THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HECTOR DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following described lands are hereby annexed by the Village of Hector, Renville County, Minnesota, and are made a part thereof:

Subdivision 1: Outlot 1 in the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 115, Range 32, constituting about five acres and situated in Renville County, Minnesota.

Subdivision 2: That part of the east one half of the southwest quarter of Section 20, Township 115 North, Range 32 West of 5th P. M. lying south of the right-of-way of the Chicago, Milwaukee, and St. Paul and Pacific Railroad, situated in Renville County, Minnesota.

Subdivision 3: The 53 feet west of Outlot B, being a part of the east one half of the northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 115 north, Range 32 west, for a distance of 536.25 feet beginning on the north with Maple Street, all as more fully shown and described by a plat of Keltgen's Addition to the Village of Hector of said lands and on file in the office of the register of deeds in and for said Renville County, Minnesota.

Subdivision 4: Outlots B and C of Hector situated in the east one half of the northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 115 north, Range 32 west, Renville County, Minnesota, all as more fully shown by a plat thereof on file in the office of the register of deeds in said county and state.
