A Proclamation for "June Dairy Month"

WHEREAS, the health of every man, woman and child is of vital public concern; and

WHEREAS, the economic welfare of all people residing in Minnesota is, of necessity, a subject of continuing grave interest; and

WHEREAS, milk and dairy products are recognized as essential to the health of every human being, young or old; and

WHEREAS, over ten million Americans are dependent on the dairy and allied industries for a livelihood and countless citizens of our own state derive economic security from this great industry; and

WHEREAS, custom has set aside one month a year to pay special tribute to the dairy industry for its contributions to the welfare of mankind; and

WHEREAS, June has been annually selected as the appropriate month to honor the industry and the people who operate it for all our benefits;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, in full appreciation of the opportunities herein presented for constructive public service, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1955, as

"JUNE DAIRY MONTH"

and do urge civic business associations to cooperate in its observance, both in public and in private, in order to increase our appreciation of milk and dairy foods, to the end that our health may be improved, our financial well-being increased, and our gratitude to the Great River expressed.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five and of the state, the ninety-eighth.
