ORDINANCE #40

An Ordinance to Extend the Boundaries of
Young America and Incorporate Additional
Territory Therein.

The Village Council of the Village of Young America, Minn.,
do ordain:

Section 1 - Village Boundary Extended:

Pursuant to a petition duly signed by William H. Bartz and
Erna Bartz, husband and wife, the owners of the tract of land de-
scribed below, designated as Tract #1, and Gilbert Schrupp, the
owner of the tract of land described below and designated as Tract
#2, to-wit:

Tract 1. - Commencing at a point 9.88 chains East of the
center post of Section 11, Township 115 North of Range
26 West; thence South 132 feet which is the point of
beginning of the premises herein to be described; thence
South 66 feet; thence West 155 Feet; thence North 66
feet; thence East 155 feet to the point of beginning,
excepting that part of Trunk Highway #25, as the same
runs across a portion of said premises.

Being situated in the Northwest Quarter of the
Southeast Quarter of Section 11, Township 115 Range 26,
and containing .24 acre more or less.

Tract 2. - Commencing at a point 9.88 chains East of the
Center post of Section 11 Township 115 North of Range 26,
West; thence South 66 feet, which is the point of beginning
of the premises herein to be described; thence South 66
feet; thence West 155 feet; thence North 66 feet, thence
East 155 feet to the point of beginning, excepting that
part of Trunk Highway #25 as the same runs across a portion
of said premises;

Lying and being in the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast
Quarter of Section 11, Township 115 Range 26 and containing
.24 acre more or less.

the territorial limits of the Village of Young America are hereby
extended to include such lands within its limits, which shall
hereafter be governed as other territory of the Village is governed.

Section 2. - Copy to be filed with Secretary of State:

The Village Clerk shall forward a certified copy of this or-
dinance to the Secretary of State.

Section 3. - Effective:

Such land shall be annexed upon the filing of a certified copy hereof with the Secretary of State.
