





We, the undersigned, constituting the board of canvassers for said county, do hereby certify that we find and have so determined that, at the special election held in the county on the 11th day of JULY, 1955, on the question whether the sale of intoxicating liquors should be prohibited in said county, 1894 votes were cast in favor of prohibiting such sale and 3679 votes were cast against prohibiting such sale, and that a majority of 1785 votes at the election was AGAINST PROHIBITING SUCH SALE
