



dred Eighty and No/100 Dollars (\$5,980.00) per year, said

fund as the Commissioner of Conservation may designate;
said appointment to commence July 1, 1955, and said appointee
to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this
commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accord-
ance with law.






I, RAYMOND HAIK, do solemnly swear that I will support
