

An ordinance annexing certain lands abutting upon and adjacent to the Incorporated Village of Hallock:

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HALLOCK DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1

That the following described lands, abutting upon and adjacent to the Incorporated Village of Hallock, Kittson County, Minnesota, be and the same are hereby annexed to such village and shall become a part of such village as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof.

Part of the North Half of the South Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161) North of Range Forty-nine (49) West, in Kittson County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning at a point Sixty-four (64) feet East of the center of said Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161) North of Range Forty-nine (49) West, in Kittson County, Minnesota, said point being on the East and West quarter line of said Section Thirteen (13) and also its point of intersection with the Westerly line of Hill Avenue in the Village of Hallock, extended Southeasterly; thence East a distance of Eight Hundred and Ten (810) feet; thence South and at right angles to the East and West quarter line of said Section Thirteen (13), a distance of Seven Hundred and Ninety (790) feet; thence West and parallel with the East and West quarter line of said Section Thirteen (13) a distance of One Thousand Fifty-six and Eighty-nine One-hundredths (1056.89) feet to the center line of State Highway No. 75; thence Northwesterly along the center line of State Highway No. 75, a distance of approximately Eight Hundred Forty-five (845) feet, more or less to its point of intersection with the East and West quarter line of said Section Thirteen (13); thence Easterly along said East and West quarter line of said Section Thirteen (13) to the point of beginning, subject to Highway easements and including established highways.

Also the following described tract:

Part of the North Half of the South Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161) North of Range Forty-nine (49) West in Kittson County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning at a point Two Hundred and Ninety-four (294) feet East and Seven Hundred and Ninety (790) feet South of the center of Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161) North of Range Forty-nine (49) West in Kittson County, Minnesota; thence West and parallel with the East and West one-quarter line of said Section Thirteen (13), a distance of Four Hundred and Seventy-six and Nine-tenths (476.9) feet to the centerline of State Highway No. 75; thence South, twenty-two degrees and thirty-four minutes

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(22°-34') East along the centerline of State Highway No. 75, a distance of Four Hundred and Eleven and One-hundredths (411.01) feet; thence Northeasterly at right angles to the centerline of State Highway No. 75, a distance of Three Hundred Forty-five and sixty-one hundredths (345.61) feet; thence North a distance of Two Hundred Forty-six and Nine-tenths (246.9) feet to the place of beginning.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.

AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior to the date of the

first publication of said *Ordinance No. 89* the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said County of Kittson, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws Minnesota, 1921.

That the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z both inclusive, of the size and kind of type in composition, printing and publication of said legal advertisement hereunto attached, viz: *abcdefghijklmnopqrstuvwxyz—8 Point.*
