WHEREAS, on the list of August Minnesota Harbors have offered to give a suitable portion of each child's fee to aid orphaned children; and

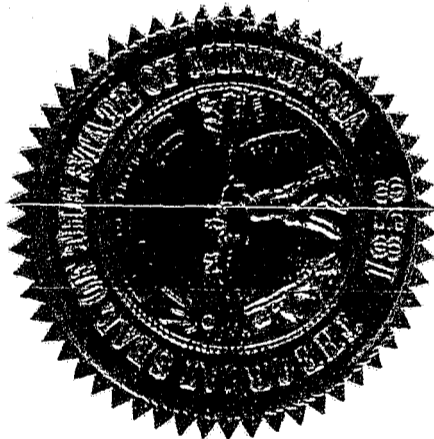
WHEREAS, it is the intent of this group of skilled artisans to aid these unfortunate youngsters who so need the help of our society; and
