

An ordinance annexing certain lands abutting upon and adjacent to the Incorporated Village of Hallock:

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HALLOCK, MINNESOTA  
DO ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1

That the following described lands, abutting upon and adjacent to the Incorporated Village of Hallock, Kittson County, Minnesota, be and the same are hereby annexed to such village and shall become a part of such village as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof:

That part of the following described tract of land lying North of the North line of the Southwest quarter (300) of Section Twelve (12), Township One Hundred Sixty-one (161) North of Range Forty-nine (49) West. Said tract is described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the Easterly right-of-way line of Trunk Highway No. 75 that is seven hundred eighty-six and nine-tenths (786.9) feet Northwest of the Northwest corner of Vanstrum's Second Addition to the Village of Hallock. Said seven hundred eighty-six and nine-tenths (786.9) feet to be measured along the right-of-way line; thence East and parallel to the North line of Vanstrum's Second Addition on a bearing of North ninety degrees (90°) East for a distance of One thousand six hundred forty-nine and forty-two hundredths (1649.42) feet; thence North thirty degrees (30°) and thirty-nine minutes (39') East, a distance of One hundred sixty-five and five-tenths (165.5) feet; thence North fifty-nine degrees thirty-four minutes (59°-34'), East a distance of Two hundred seventy-nine (279) feet; thence North thirty degrees, twenty-seven minutes (30°-27') East, a distance of Four hundred and six (406) feet; thence North seventy degrees thirty-five minutes (70°-35') East, a distance of One hundred sixty-nine and three-tenths (169.3) feet; thence South forty-two degrees, thirty-four minutes (42°-34') West, a distance of Two hundred ninety-nine and one-tenth (299.1) feet; thence North Fifty-seven degrees, twenty-six minutes (57°-26') East a distance of Three hundred ninety-nine and seven-tenths (399.7) feet; thence North ten degrees, twenty-six minutes (10°-26') East, a distance of One hundred ninety-nine and three-tenths (199.3) feet; thence North twenty degrees, thirty-one minutes (20°-31') East, a distance of Two hundred eighty-two and three hundredths (282.03) feet; thence North ninety degrees (90°) East, a distance of One thousand three hundred fifty-four and ninety-seven hundredths (1354.97) feet to the Easterly right-of-way line of Trunk Highway No. 75; thence Southeast along the Easterly right-of-way line of Trunk Highway No. 75 a distance of One thousand two hundred thirty-four and nineteen hundredths (1234.19) feet to the point of beginning, containing thirty-six and sixty-three hundredths (36.63) acres.

first publication of said *Ordinance # 91* the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said County of Kittson, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws Minnesota, 1921.
