

ORDINANCE NO. 39

AN ORDINANCE DETACHING FROM THE VILLAGE OF COON RAPIDS, MINNESOTA A TRACT OF LAND, NAMELY; LOTS ONE, TWO, AND THREE (1, 2, 3), BLOCK C, RIVERVIEW HEIGHTS, ANOKA COUNTY, MINNESOTA BEING LAND ABUTTING THE VILLAGE OF FRIDLEY.

The Village Council of Coon Rapids, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to a Petition proper and sufficient, signed by all of the owners of Lots One, Two, and Three (1, 2, 3), Block C, Riverview Heights, Anoka County, Minnesota, requesting that said Lots be detached from the Village of Coon Rapids for the purpose of having them annexed to the Village of Fridley, Minnesota.

Section 2. That said land is a part of a tract consisting of two additional lots which now lie within the boundary of the Village of Fridley, and that said petitioners assert that the change will be for the benefit of both the Village and the land affected.

Section 3. That said tract of land, consisting of Lots One, Two, and Three (1, 2, 3), Riverview Heights, Anoka County, Minnesota is hereby declared to be detached from the Village of Coon Rapids, Minnesota effective September 7, 1955, but not before the passage of an Ordinance annexing the said property by the Village of Fridley.

Passed this 7th day of September, 1955 by the Village Council of Coon Rapids.
