ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE VILLAGE OF FRIDLEY, MINNESOTA, LOTS ONE, TWO, AND THREE (1, 2, 3), BLOCK G, RIVERVIEW HEIGHTS, ANOKA COUNTY, MINNESOTA, BEING LAND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE AND WHICH HAS BEEN DETACHED FROM THE ADJOINING VILLAGE OF CCON RAPIDS, AND WHERE THE CHANGE WILL BE FOR THE BENEFIT OF BOTH THE VILLAGE AND THE LAND AFFECTED.

The Village Council of Fridley, Minnesota do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Whereas a Petition has been presented to the Village Gouncil signed by all the owners of Lots One, Two, and Three (1, 2, 3), Block C. Riverview Heights, Anoka County, Minnesota, requesting that said land, when it has been detached from the Village of Coon Rapids, be annexed to the Village of Fridley. That said Petition was made pursuant to M.S.A. 412.061.

Section 2. That the Village of Coon Rapids has by Ordinance passed on the _____ day of September, 1955, detached said lands from the Village of Coon Rapids.

Section 3. The Council finds that the change will be for the benefit of both the Village of Fridley and the land affected.

Section 4. That said tract of land, namely; Lots One, Two, and Three (1, 2, 3), Block C. Riverview Heights, Anoka County, Minnesota, is hereby declared annexed and to be an addition to the Village of Fridley, Minnesota,
