A Proclamation for "Radio and Television" Week

WHEREAS, the merits of radio and television have been effectively demonstrated in the homes of the people of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the radio and television industry, through research and through constant refinement of methods has succeeded in serving many other fields of endeavor with electronics developments and in providing the public with constantly greater values;

WHEREAS, the vital role of television in our economy, in providing home entertainment to the people including the shut-ins and in educational activity is now being proclaimed in the public interest;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of September 18 through 24 as

"RADIO AND TELEVISION WEEK"

in Minnesota, and I hereby call upon the citizens of Minnesota to share in its observance.


