

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Miles Lord, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, do hereby constitute and appoint Bruce James of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Attorney to act for the Board of Barber Examiners of the State of Minnesota, and to serve at my pleasure, his compensation to be paid from and out of the funds of the said Board of Barber Examiners and on recommendation of the Board fixed at Seventy-five and No/100 Dollars (\$75.00) per month. When the work called for consumes more than $1\frac{1}{2}$ days per month then verified statements shall be submitted not more frequently than twice a month showing the number of days expended or fractions of a day expended by counsel in the performance of his duties under this appointment, together with a list of work performed or services rendered. The compensation and the payment of expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of his duties shall continue until otherwise determined. Said appointment shall take effect on October 1, 1955.




