PETITION FOR INCORPORATION

TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF THE COUNTY OF ST. LOUIS MINNESOTA.

We, the undersigned, residents of the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your Honorable Board to fix a time and place when and where the resident legal voters within said territory may vote on the question of incorporating the same as a village, pursuant to Laws of Minnesota, 1955, Chapter 390 and Minnesota Statutes 1953, Chapter 412, and for that purpose respectfully state:

1. That the Town of Mesaba is an organized Town and has a population of more than 500 persons and a platted area on which at least half of the population of the Town resides.
2. That the said Town of Mesaba contains within its limits both lands containing taconite as described in Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 298.23, and a plant or plants for the concentration of taconite, either under construction or in operation.
3. That all of your petitioners are qualified voters and residents within the territory hereinafter described, and each has resided continuously within said territory for at least one year prior to the date of this petition.
4. That none of the territory hereinafter described is now a part of any incorporated City or Village.
5. That the territory which it is proposed to incorporate consists partly of lands which have been platted into lots and blocks, which plat or plats have been duly and legally made and certified according to the laws of this State and are filed in the office of the Register of Deeds, in and for St. Louis County, Minnesota, and partly of unplatted lands which adjoin the platted area and are also subject to village government. All of said lands, platted and unplatted, lie entirely within the County of St. Louis, Minnesota, and the description of said lands both platted and unplatted, is as follows: All of the land in the Town of Mesaba, St.

6. The boundaries of the foregoing lands are as follows:

The North boundary line is the North line of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, Township 59 North, Range 14 West of the Fourth P. M.; the East boundary line is the East line of Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36, Township 59 North, Range 14 West of the Fourth P. M. and the East line of Sections 1, 12, 13 and 24, Township 58 North, Range 14 West of the Fourth P. M.; the South boundary line is the South line of Sections 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24, Township 58 North, Range 14 West of the Fourth P. M.; and the West boundary line is the West line of Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30 and 31, Township 59 North, Range 14 West of the Fourth P. M. and the West line of Sections 6, 7, 18 and 19, Township 58 North, Range 14, West of the Fourth P. M.

7. The quantity of land, both platted and unplatted, embraced within the foregoing description is 38,400 acres, be the same more or less.

8. The foregoing lands, both platted and unplatted, and bounded as described contain a resident population of 561 persons, as ascertained by a census which was commenced on the 8th day of August, 1955, and completed on the 3rd day of September, 1955, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

9. The name of the village proposed to be incorporated is the Village of Hoyt Lakes, Minnesota.

Your petitioners also request that at the time and place and at the same election the following question be submitted to the qualified voters residing within said territory:

"Shall Optional Plan A, modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the Clerk, Treasurer and Assessor, be adopted for the government of the village if the village is incorporated?"

HULTSTRAND:

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated September 30, 1955, requesting that an election be held on the question of incorporating certain territory described therein as the Village of Hoyt Lakes, Minnesota, was duly presented to this board on the 10th day of October, 1955; and

WHEREAS, said petition also requested that the question of adopting Optional Plan A of village government be submitted to the voters at the same election; and

WHEREAS, said petition is in proper form and it appears therefrom that the same was signed by the requisite number of qualified persons and that the territory described therein contains a resident population of 561 persons,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of St. Louis, Minnesota:

1. That an election is hereby called and directed to be held on the 7th day of November, 1955, at the Hoyt Lakes area Fire Hall, at which election all qualified voters residing within the territory described in said petition may vote upon the following questions:

First: For or against the incorporation of said territory as the Village of Hoyt Lakes, Minnesota; and

Second: Shall Optional Plan A, modifying the standard plan of village government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village if the village is incorporated?

2. The polls at said election shall be open from 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon until 8:00 o'clock in the afternoon of said day.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Mrs. Elizabeth Hostetter and Mrs. Anne Vikingstad and Mrs. Evelyn Stewart all of the Hoyt Lakes area, and all residents and residing within said territory, are hereby appointed judges at said election, and they shall conduct the same so far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the County Auditor cause notice of said election to be given in the manner prescribed by law.

Adopted and approved by the County Board of Commissioners of St. Louis County, Minnesota this 10th day of October, 1955.
