A Proclamation for "Truck Transportation Week"

WHEREAS, the business of transporting vitally needed goods and commodities as well as our military supplies has fallen to a greater degree than ever on the shoulders of the trucking industry, and

WHEREAS, that industry has undertaken this mammoth task with economic intelligence, with diligence and with an efficiency that can be characterized as typically American, and

WHEREAS, the welfare of this State and of every other state in our nation depends in a great measure upon the continued excellent conduct of the transportation business, and

WHEREAS, this rapid, flexible means of transport has changed our merchandising methods, and has brought regular transportation service directly to the homes of every commercial establishment in the State, and

WHEREAS, the trucking industry has demonstrated that it stands ready to do valiant service to the people of the State and the Nation in the event of an emergency,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of November 13 to November 19, 1955, as

"TRUCK TRANSPORTATION WEEK"

and urge the people to consider the great accomplishment of our truckers and the system they represent and to salute the men and women who are associated with it on this memorable occasion.
