THE UNDERSIGNED, Dana E. McCutchan, duly elected qualified and acting Village Clerk of the Village of Bloomington, Hennepin County, Minnesota, hereby certifies that on the 6th day of December, 1955, the following question was submitted at a regular Village election in the Village of Bloomington, to-wit:

"Shall Optional Plan B providing for the council-manager form of village government be adopted for the government of the village?"

The results of said election were duly canvassed by the Village Council of the Village of Bloomington acting as a canvassing board on the 7th day of December, 1955.

At said election there were 5371 votes cast upon the question. There were 3093 Yes votes and there were 2278 No votes. The Village Council therefore determined that Optional Plan B was adopted by the Village of Bloomington.
