

CERTIFICATE OF RESULT OF LOCAL OPTION ELECTION
IN THE VILLAGE OF MARINE-ON-ST. CROIX

To the Secretary of the State of Minnesota:

I, Kenneth L. Anderson Clerk of the Village of
Marine-On-St. Croix, Minnesota, do hereby certify that at the
regular election held in the Village of Marine-On-St. Croix on
December 6, 1955, the following question was submitted to the
voters of the Village.

"Shall licenses be granted for the sale of intoxicating
liquor in the Village of Marine-On-St. Croix?"

I further certify that the affirmative votes cast on the
foregoing proposition were 62 and the negative votes were
106, and the question failed to receive an affirmative
majority of the votes cast upon the question.
