ORDINANCE NO. 143

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS AND INCORPORATE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY THEREIN

The Village council of Sauk Rapids does ordain:

15-01

Section 1. Village Boundaries Extended. Pursuant to a petition

daily signed by all of the owners of the land described as follows:

That certain real estate situate in the County of Benton, State of Minnesota, to-wit, that part of the Northwest one-quarter (N.W. 1/4) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township Thirty-six (36), North, Range Thirty-one (31) West, to-wit:- Beginning at a point Thirty-three (33) feet East and One Hundred (100.0) feet south of the Northwest corner of said Sec. 23, T. 36, N. R. 31 W:- Thence due East and parallel with the North line of said Sec. 23 for One Hundred Seventy (170.00) feet:- Thence due South and parallel with the West line of said Sec. 23 for Nine Hundred Sixty-five and twenty-one hundredths (965.21) feet:- Thence running South Forty-five degrees & eight minutes East (S. 45°08' E.) for a distance of Two Hundred Ninety-five and eight-tenths (295.80) feet:- Thence at right angles Southwesterly along the Southerly line of Ninth Street North (formerly Irvine Street) for a distance of One Hundred Sixty (160.00) feet to an intersection with the Easterly line of Fourth Avenue North (formerly Summit Street) in the Village of Sauk Rapids:- Thence at right angles Northwesterly along the said Easterly line of said Fourth Avenue North produced for a distance of Three Hundred Seventy-six and five-tenths (376.50) feet to a point on the easterly right of way line of a township road Thirty-three (33) feet East and Ten Hundred Twenty-four and thirty-five hundredths (1024.35) feet South of the said Northwest corner of said Sec. 23-36-31:- Thence due North and parallel with the said West line of said Sec. 23 and distant East Thirty-three (33) feet therefrom for 1024.35 feet to the place of beginning and there terminating, said tract containing Five and two-tenths (5.20) acres (more or less) and platted as "Larson's Addition."

the territorial limits of the village are hereby extended to include such land within its limits, which shall hereafter be governed as other territory of the village is governed.

Section 2. Copies to be Filed. The village clerk shall forward

a certified copy of this ordinance to the secretary of state and to the County Auditor for Benton County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Effect. Such land shall be annexed upon the filing

of the certified copies hereof with the secretary of state and the County Auditor.
