PETITION FOR AN ELECTION ON THE QUESTION  
OF INCORPORATION OF THE PROPOSED VILLAGE OF  
GREENWOOD

To the Honorable County Board  
of the County of Hennepin:

Your petitioners respectfully represent:

I.

That all of the territory hereinafter described is situated in the County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, and within the Town of Excelsior and not in any incorporated city or village; that such territory includes land which has been platted into lots and blocks in the manner provided by law and includes unplatted lands adjoining such platted area which are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government; that the said territory contains a resident population of not less than 100 persons; that a census list showing the buildings in said area used for residences and the number of people living in each is hereto attached, said census showing a total population of 393 persons residing within said territory, which contains a quantity of land of 247 acres more or less.

II.

That the undersigned petitioners are voters who have resided continuously within the said territory proposed to be incorporated for at least two years prior to the date of this petition.

III.

That the territory proposed to be incorporated under the name of the Village of Greenwood is described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the Southerly boundary of the Village of Deephaven with the shore of Lake Minnetonka in the North

One-Half (N 1/2) of Section Twenty-Six (26), Township One Hundred Seventeen (117), Range Twenty-three (23), the said Southerly boundary being the boundary of the Village of Deephaven as existing on the 8th day of November, 1955; thence Easterly along said Southerly boundary of the Village of Deephaven to its intersection with the West line of Lot One Hundred Two (102), Auditor's Subdivision No. One Hundred Forty-one (141), Hennepin County, Minn.; thence South along said West line of said Lot 102 and continuing southerly along the projection of said West line to the Center Line of County Road No. Eighty-two (82); thence westerly and southerly along the said Center line of said County Road #82 until said County Road #82 is joined by a town road as laid out and joining onto said County Road #82 immediately to the Southwest of Lot Ten (10), Block Ten (10) Minnetonka Manor; thence continuing easterly and southerly along the center line of said town road as laid out, the said town road lying north of Lots 87, 88, 89, and 90 Auditor's Subdivision One Hundred Forty-One (141), Hennepin County, Minn., and that part of Endsley's Minnetonka Addition lying between said Lots 89 and 90, to the intersection of said town road with County Road No. Five (5); thence Southwesterly along the center line of said County Road No. Five (5) to its intersection with the center line of State Highway No. Seven (7); thence westerly and southerly along said center line of State Highway No. 7 to its intersection with the Easterly boundary of the Village of Excelsior, the said Easterly boundary being the boundary of the Village of Excelsior as existing on the 8th day of November, 1955; thence north along said easterly boundary to the southerly shore of St. Alban's Bay of Lake Minnetonka; thence easterly along said shore and continuing northerly and westerly along the shore of said bay to the shore of Lake Minnetonka and continuing northerly along said shore to the point of beginning, including islands within said St. Alban's Bay described as: that portion of Lot 17, Partridge Heights, lying east of the said easterly boundary of the Village of Excelsior, and Lot 16, Partridge Heights, and Government Lot 8, Sec. 35, Township 117, Range 23.
