

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF
CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF
EXCELSIOR, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Excelsior, ordains:

Section I. Annexation.

That the land hereinafter described in Section II hereof, the council having determined that the annexation thereof is to the best interests of the village and of territory affected, is hereby annexed to and included within the boundaries of the Village of Excelsior pursuant to a petition of all of the owners of said land and in accordance with M. S. A., Section 412.041, Subdivision 4.

Section II. Description of land annexed.

That the land hereby annexed is situated in Hennepin County, Minnesota, and is described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 110 and that part of Lot 111, lying Westerly of a line which is 110 feet Easterly of and parallel to the Westerly line of said lot, Auditor's Sub-division Number 120, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

Section III. Certified copies to be filed.

The Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance in the office of the Auditor of Hennepin County and in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Section IV. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and the filing of said certified copies aforesaid.
