

ORDINANCE NO. 2 6 2

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON,
MINNESOTA

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, DO ORDAIN:

NOW, WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 413.14, and all amendments thereto,
of Minnesota Statutes for 1941, all owners of property hereinafter described
and abutting upon the City of Worthington, have petitioned the City Council
of said City of Worthington to have such property annexed to said City; and

WHEREAS it is desired that said territory become a part of said City
of Worthington, the same as if it had been originally a part thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, The following described territory is hereby declared
to be a part of the City of Worthington; to wit,

That part of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 15, Township 102
North, Range 40 West of the 5th P.M., in the County of Nobles and State of
Minnesota, described as follows; to wit, Commencing at the southeast cor-
ner of said Section 15, Township 102 North, Range 40 West, as the point of
beginning; thence northwesterly along the center line of the highway desig-
nated as Diagonal Road, a distance of 515 feet; thence southwesterly with an
interior angle of 96 degrees 25 minutes, a distance of 120 feet; thence in
a southeasterly direction with an interior angle of 83 degrees 40 minutes,
a distance of 412 feet to the south line of said Section 15; thence easterly
along the south line of said Section 15, a distance of 159 feet to the point
of beginning.
