

ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE VILLAGE OF COLD SPRING.

The council of the Village of Cold Spring, Minnesota, does ordain as follows:

Section 1.

That the corporate limits of the village of Cold Spring, Minnesota, be and hereby are altered to include within said limits the following described real estate:

Starting at the intersection of the center line of Fifth Avenue and the northerly line of the corporate limits of the Village of Cold Spring (said point being the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15) Township One Hundred twenty-three (123) of Range Thirty (30), Stearns County, Minnesota) thence East thirty-three (33) feet to the Easterly right of way line of the existing County Aid Road, thence north along said easterly right of way line a distance of two hundred forty-two (242) feet, thence West a distance of seven hundred seventeen and five-tenths (717.5) feet, thence South two hundred fifty-three and seven-tenths (253.7) feet to the northerly line of the corporate limits of Cold Spring; thence East along said line a distance of six hundred eighty-three and six-tenths (683.6) feet to the point of beginning and there terminating.

Section 2.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication.
