A Proclamation for "Minnosota Wolfaro Week"

- VHENEAS, one of the major obligations and responsibilities of civilized society, a responsibility which is shared by government, by religious organizations, and by other voluntary private organizations, is to provide for the needs and the welfare of the people; and particularly to be concerned with those who because of youth, age, or other handicaps or special circumstances, require help in meeting their physical, escial and spiritual needs; and
- WINDERAS, several agencies of government and many private organizations are dedicated to serving the welfere of the people and are carrying out this task through the efforts of professionally trained and skilled personnel and with the assistance of countless local officials and volunteers who give of their time, resources, and ability to contribute to the welfare and happiness of others; and
- WEREAS, these agencies and individuals are joined together in the Minnesota Wolfare Conference, which-during the first week of April-is holding its sixtythird annual mosting to consider common objectives in meeting the needs of the people and methods by which these needs can be met meet effectively;
- WIFRIAS, it is of utmost importance to the success of these effects, both public and private, that the people of Minnesota become fully aware of the needs that exist, of the resources available to meet those needs, of the money needed, both from taxos and from private contributions, to carry out an effective program, and of the human values that result from that invest-

NOW, THEREFORE, I. Orville L. Freeman, Covernor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby preclaim the week of April 2 to 7, 1956 as

"MINNESOTA THELFARE THEK"

and urgo all oftisons of Manosota to give particular attention during that week to the problems that exist, to the effects of our welfare agencies to meet vital human needs, and to the results of such efforts in bringing about higher standards of health, of economic, development, of social progress, and of human happiness.
