

Ordinance Annexing Unplatted  
Land Not Exceeding 200 Acres  
in Area

ORDINANCE NO. 42

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the Village of Maple Plain to Include Certain Unplatted Land Not Exceeding 200 Acres in Area.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated January 17, 1956, and signed by all the owners of the land hereinafter described, requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the council on the 19th day of January, 1956.

The Council of the Village of Maple Plain ordains:

**Section 1. Declaration.** It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

**Section 2. Territory Annexed.** The corporate limits of the Village are hereby extended to include the territory lying and being in the County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, and described as follows:

The Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township One Hundred Eighteen (118), Range Twenty-four (24).

That part of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township One Hundred Eighteen (118), Range Twenty-four (24), lying Northerly of the Northerly right-of-way line of the Great Northern Railroad.

The East Half of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township One Hundred Eighteen (118), Range Twenty-four (24).

**Section 3. Filing.** The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State and in the office of the County Auditor of Hennepin County.

**Section 4. Effective Date of Annexation.** Annexation shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3.

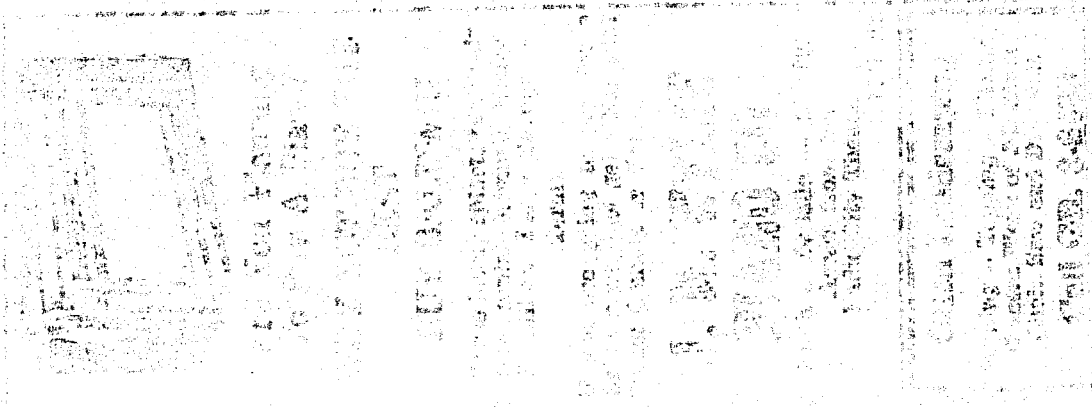
