A Proclamation for "Religious Emphasis Week"

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Federation of Women's Clubs is furthering special programs for the week of March 25 - April 1, 1956, as

"RELIGIOUS EMPHASIS WEEK"

and urge all the people of Minnesota to give particular attention to the observance of religious and spiritual values, each according to his own faith, and, thus, contribute toward deepening the spiritual life and advancing moral and religious ideals in our state, our nation, and the world.
