

RESOLUTION CANTASSING RESULT OF
SPECIAL VILLAGE ELECTION ON ADOPTION OF OPTIONAL
PLAN A.

BE IT RESOLVED By the Village Council of the Village of Lauderdale,
Ransom County, Minnesota as follows:

1. It is hereby determined that the vote at the special
village election held in the village on Tuesday, March 20, 1956
on the question hereinafter set forth was as hereinafter set
forth:

"SHALL OPTIONAL PLAN A, MODIFYING THE
STANDARD PLAN OF VILLAGE GOVERNMENT BY PRO-
VIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT BY THE COUNCIL OF
THE CLERK AND TREASURER, BE ADOPTED FOR THE
GOVERNMENT OF THIS VILLAGE."

2. By reason of the foregoing vote it is hereby deter-
mined that the Optional Plan A form of village government shall
hereafter be and remain in force and effect in accordance with
the laws of the State of Minnesota.

3. The village council shall continue as presently
constituted until the expiration of the present term of the
incumbent clerk. At the village election preceding the ex-
piration of ~~the expiration of~~ the present term of the incumbent
clerk and at the village election every third year thereafter,
two trustees shall be elected and at intervening village
elections, one trustee shall be elected, each for a three year
term. The incumbent clerk and treasurer shall continue to serve
until the expiration of their respective terms and thereafter
the offices of the clerk and treasurer shall be filled by ap-
pointment by the village council.

Inasmuch as this village is situated within Ransom
County, Minnesota, which county has a county assessor, it is
hereby determined that no action need be taken by this council
in connection with the adoption of Optional Plan A insofar as
the office of assessor is concerned.

4. The village clerk is hereby authorized and directed
to provide the county auditor and the secretary of state with
certified copies of this resolution as evidence of the adoption
of Optional Plan A by the Village of Lauderdale, as required by
law.
