A Proclamation for "National Music Week"

WHEREAS, the appreciation and enjoyment of good music has been an important aspect of our American heritage; and

WHEREAS, throughout our land, communities and local organizations have banded together to promote the performance of the cherished classics as well as the new works of young American composers; and

WHEREAS, the National and Inter-American Music Week Committee is calling attention to this effort to encourage wholesome recreation through broader appreciation of great music by the observance of National Music Week;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 6 - 13, 1956, as

"NATIONAL MUSIC WEEK"

and urge the citizens of Minnesota to support and enjoy the programs sponsored in connection with this observance.
