WHEREAS, May is the month of the Senior Citizens Hobby Shows, the month for Mother's Day, and the month when it is customary to honor our Senior Citizens;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1956, as
