

Ordinance No. 133

An ordinance annexing a certain
Outlot to the village of Le Roy.

Upon petition duly made, and filed by all affected property owners, the village council of the village of Le Roy, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION 1. That the following described Outlot abutting upon the incorporated Village of Le Roy, Minnesota, be and the same is hereby annexed to such Village and shall become a part of such Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The south one-half (S 1/2) of Outlot Five (5), in Section Twenty-seven (27), Township One Hundred One (101) North Range Fourteen (14) West, Mower County, Minnesota, according to the plat thereof recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, Mower County, Minnesota.
