A Proclamation for Public Employees Week

WHEREAS, city, county and state public employees have made an outstanding contribution to safety, health and general welfare in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, our public employees are dedicated to improving Minnesota for all persons and groups; and

WHEREAS, this service to the people and the future of Minnesota is sometimes not fully recognized or appreciated; and

WHEREAS, public employees over the nation are devoting the first week of June to furthering good will and understanding between public employees and the citizenship they serve;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 1 through 7th, 1956 as

"PUBLIC EMPLOYEES WEEK"

and call upon all citizens of Minnesota to recognize the work being done each day by these dedicated public servants.
