A Proclamation for "June Dairy Month"

WHEREAS, the health of every man, woman and child is of vital public concern, and the food values of milk and dairy products are recognized as essential to the health of every human being, young or old; and

WHEREAS, the production and processing of milk and dairy products constitute one of the most important economic assets of the people of Minnesota, and are essential to the economic well being of all of the people on our farms, in our villages and in our cities; and

WHEREAS, it is customary to set aside one month each year in which to pay tribute to the importance of our dairy industry in our economic life to emphasize the value of dairy products and their consumption in the health and well-being of every individual,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1956, as

"JUNE DAIRY MONTH"

and urge all individuals and all civic and economic groups to cooperate in its observance, to give especial attention to disseminating information and understanding of the value and importance of dairy products in our economic life and in the improved health and vigor of our people.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six and of the State, the ninety-ninth.
