A Proclamation for "Your Bank Week for America"

WHEREAS, the purchase of United States Savings Bonds by our people helps to build their financial security and aids our government in the wise management of the national debt and our savings invested in these government securities finance the defense of our freedoms and protect the purchasing power of our dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Savings Bonds Committee through its volunteer leaders is a fine example of Americans working together for the good of all and this Committee is assisted by the banks of our state and all publicity media, including press, radio and television stations, in the interest of public service to state and nation;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 14 through June 21, 1956, as


"YOUR BANK WEEK FOR AMERICA"


