WHEREAS, June 29th is the fifteenth anniversary of the death of this world renowned statesman and musician,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the 29th day of June, 1956, as

and urge all groups and persons in Minnesota to mark the day with appropriate observances.


