#### RESOLUTION OF COUNCIL CALLING ANNEXATION ELECTION AND DESIGNATING ELECTION JUDGES

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated June 29, 1956, requesting that an election be held on the question of annexing certain territory described therein to the City of Wayzata, Minnesota, was duly presented to this council on the 2nd day of July, 1956; and

WHEREAS, said petition is in proper form and it appears therefrom that the same was signed by the requisite number of qualified persons, that the territory described therein contains a resident population of 246 persons, and that no part thereof is located more than one and one-half miles from the corporate limits of the City of Wayzata.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the City of Wayzata, Minnesota:

- 1. It is hereby determined that annexation of the following territory would be to the best interests of the territory and of the City;

We, the undersigned, acting pursuant to Sec. 413.12, Minnesota Statutes Annotated, hereby petition the City Council of the City of Wayzata, Hennepin County, Minnesota, as the governing body of said City, for the annexation to the City of Wayzata of the territory hereinafter described, and to call an election for the determination of the proposed annexation to said City of Wayzata of the territory located in said Hennepin County described as follows:

The undersigned petitioners prior to the making of this petition, first caused to be taken on June 28, 1956, a census of the resident population of the territory above described and proposed to be annexed, and the population of said territory was so duly found to be in excess of seventy-five (75) persons.

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The boundaries of the territory proposed to be so annexed are as stated in the above description of said territory.

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The quantity of land embraced in the territory above described and proposed to be annexed is two hundred forty-three (243) acres, more or less.

The territory hereinablem described adjoins the City of Hayzata, no part of said territory is included in any incorporated city or village, and no part of said territory is more than one and one-half (1) sailes from the present limits of the City of Wayzata.

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The number of actual residents in the territory above described and proposed to be annowed was two hundred forty-six (246) on June 28, 1956, the date when the census above referred to was taken.
