A Proclemation for "Woodsow Wilson Centennial Year"

HHEREAS, Voodrov Vilson, President of the United States from 1913 to 1921, was one of the foremost leaders not only in the United States of America but in the entire world; and

the statesmenship of Woodrow Wilson contributed immensurably to better government in the United States, to the public welfare of all of the people, to the enhancement of freedom and responsibility in political life, and to the development of leadership on the part of the United States of America in the furthering of conditions that would contribute to understanding and peace among all the nations of the earth; and

MMEREAS, the year 1956 marks the centennial anniversary of the birth of Weedrow Wilson, and the Congress of the United States has taken action to insure the commemoration of that event, and of the principles and ideals for which Woodrow Wilson is known;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freemen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the year 1956 as

"MOODROW WILSON CENTERINAL YEAR"

and urge the people of Minnesota, through private and governmental organizations, to give particular attention to the principles of sound and responsible government, of consern for the people's wellfire and for equality of opportunity, of devotion to the ideals of freedom and of peace, toward the achievement of which Woodrow Wilson made k such great contributions.

IN WITNESS UNEREOF, I hereunto set my hand and coused the Greet Seal of the State of Minnesota to be offixed at the State Capitol this twenty-sixth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six and of the State, the ninety-ninth.
