A Proclamation for "Plumbing-Heating-Cooling" Month

WHEREAS, we recognize that the home is the hearth of the American Way of Life; and

WHEREAS, we strive to provide, by private enterprise and initiative, a modern, comfortable home for every American family seeking such a goal; and

WHEREAS, twenty-seven million American homes have inadequate or no private bathroom facilities of any kind; and

WHEREAS, twenty million American homes have no central heating plants and many more have inadequate heating systems; and

WHEREAS, the absence of such conveniences tends to lower property values and cause slum or blighted neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, it is our duty as Americans and homeowners to eliminate and prevent slums and below-standard housing for the sake of our country and good of our children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of August, 1956 as

"PLUMBING-HEATING-COOLING MONTH"

and urge all citizens to recognize this effort for better home facilities.
