A Proclamation for "Soft Water Week"

WHEREAS, the welfare of its people is of major concern to the duly elected officials of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, huge sums of money are expended each year in Minnesota to combat the effects of hard water; and

WHEREAS, the water conditioning industry, through long years of research and constant improvement of water conditioning techniques has effectively demonstrated the many benefits of soft water in the home, in business, on our farms and in the conservation of our natural resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period from September 15 to September 23, 1956 as

"SOFT WATER WEEK"

and call upon the citizens of Minnesota to share in its observance.

I WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this tenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six and of the state, the ninety-ninth.
