OF TERMITTORY The Village Council of Savage, Minnesota, do ordain as follows: SECTION I. The property to be described in the following paragraph, being un-platted land situated within the cor-porate limits of the Village of Sav-age, may be and here is detached from the Village of Savage, The de-scription of the property above men-tioned is as follows to-wit: That part of Section 31.
