PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, There is now on the statutes an act providing that the third Tuesday in June of each year be designated as Good Roads Day, to be devoted to the improvement of the public highways in the State, and the said date falling on an election day this year, which would interfere with a proper observance of the day,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Adolph G. Eberhart, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by authority duly vested in me, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, the 23rd day of June, as Good Roads Day, and do hereby call upon all citizens of the State to observe the day by contributing labor or funds toward the improvement of our streets and roads. The governing bodies of all towns, villages and cities, are instructed to make such appropriation as the local needs require and to arrange for receipt of contributions and execution of work, and to give all assistance possible in advancing the cause of better roads on this day.

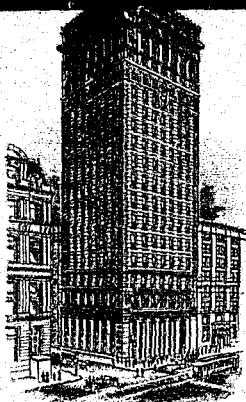
