A Proclamation for "Parent Teacher Enrollment Week"

WHEREAS, The Minnesota Congress of Parents and Teachers is an organization dedicated to the achievement of the best possible educational opportunities for our children; and

WHEREAS, these goals toward which the efforts of the Congress of Parents and Teachers are directed are of utmost importance to our entire society, to the maintenance of human freedom, to the development and happiness of every individual, and to the continued progress of our communities, our state and our nation; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Congress of Parents and Teachers last year had a total enrollment of 224,669, a gain of 12,706 over the previous year and is again sponsoring in the month of October an effort to enroll members and to inspire the active cooperation of all those interested in helping to insure to our children and our future the greatest benefits that an adequate educational program can provide;

AND, WHEREAS, I, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1936, as

"PARENT TEACHER ENROLLMENT WEEK"

and urge all citizens of Minnesota to give special attention to activities through which they can help to further progress in our program for the education of our children and the future of our society.
